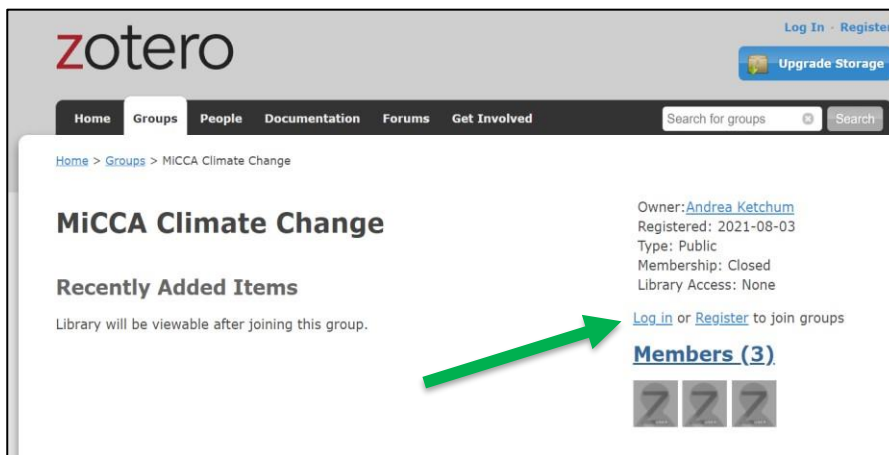


How to Access the [MiCCA Climate Change](https://www.zotero.org/groups/4392181/micca_climate_change) library via [Zotero Groups](#).

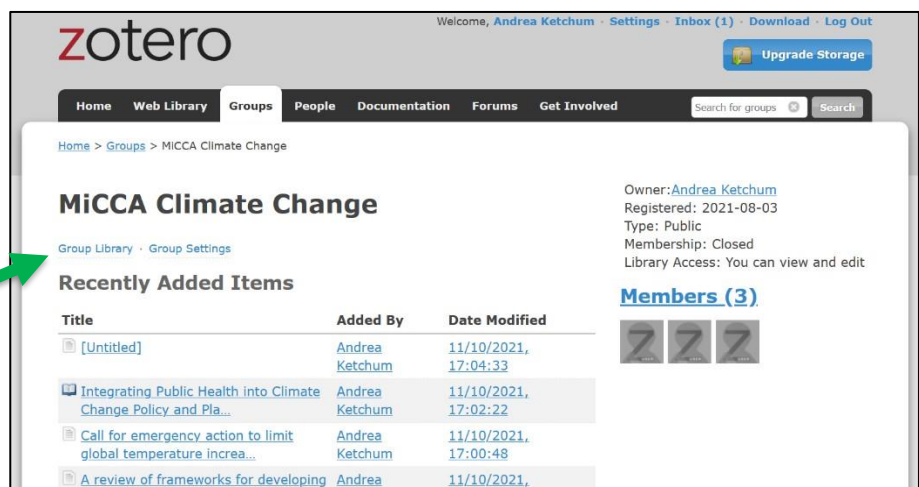

1. Bookmark the URL for the *MiCCA Climate Change* library:
https://www.zotero.org/groups/4392181/micca_climate_change
2. **Register for the Zotero group MiCCA Climate Change.**
 - a. Once you are in the MiCCA Climate Change website, click on the “Register” link on the right (above “Members”) as shown below.
 - b. You will be asked to enter a
 - Username - all one word
 - Email address - enter twice
 - Password - enter twice
 - Click the “Register” button - Done!
 - Log out
 - c. **IMPORTANT!** After you have registered, **check your email for a confirmation from Zotero.** You must confirm your email address to activate your library membership!
3. Finally, **log in** using your new username and password. The Log in link is next to the Registration link.



4. Log in to enter the MiCCA Climate Change portal. Click on the tiny “*Group Library*” text on the left to enter the full searchable library.

- This is only the opening portal of the library.
- Click on link to enter full “Group Library”



General Use:

- All content is full-text and Open Access, with a few noted exceptions of limited personal use.
- Click on a Topic folder on left to focus (Tip: Articles are cross-indexed, appear in multiple folders)
- Double-click title to open an article.
- Search box in upper right. Search by Title word, Author or Year.
- Sort function: click each column heading to sort all articles in that folder.
